

Week no. 1 A visit to the Park





SLOs:



Theme: Sea Animals




SLOs:




Week no. 4 Theme: Colors




SLOs:


- 1. Teach children to recognize and identify primary and secondary colors by names, which help in developing their vocabulary and cognitive skills.

Week no. 5 Theme: Transport




- 1. Keep the vehicle clean and sanitized to maintain a healthy environment for the children.


